## Embarkation Port General Information

### San Francisco, CA, USA - General Information

#### Port Details

The port of San Francisco is located along the Embarcadero waterfront. Guests enter from Embarcadero into a small lobby where soft security checks take place. Guests are required to present a government photo ID and cruise travel document.

Pier 27 is the primary cruise terminal in San Francisco, but Pier 35 may be used on certain voyages.

#### Luggage Handling

Prior to arriving at the pier, attach a Princess luggage tag to all pieces of checked luggage in addition to your personal identification tag. For guests on Princess Transfers, please ensure you attach luggage tags prior to boarding your transportation at the airport. Additional Princess Luggage tags can be obtained at the pier.

Upon arrival, take your luggage to the the designated drop off area. Porter assistance is also available. Luggage is scanned and then loaded onboard and delivered to your stateroom. Please be advised that curbside porters are not employees of Princess Cruises. You are responsible for your belongings at all times.

For security reasons, we advise you keep your hand luggage, including laptops, cameras, any medications, all travel documents and other valuables, in your possession at all time

#### Distance and Taxi Information

From/To: San Francisco Airport/Pier  
Distance/Time: 20 miles/45 minutes  
Taxi Fare: \$50/\$60\*

From/To: San Francisco Airport to City Center  
Distance/Time: 18 miles/30 minutes  
Taxi Fare: \$40/\$50\*

Taxis are available curbside on the Embarcadero just past the exit of the terminal. The average taxi holds 3 guests and up to 4 pieces of luggage, including carry-on. Local Taxis accept US dollars and drivers speak English.

\*Please note prices listed above are approximate, in local currency, and subject to change.

The two cruise terminals, Pier 27 and Pier 35, are two blocks apart (0.2 miles), about a 5-minute walk.

#### Directions to Port / Driving Directions

##### From the East Bay, Bay Bridge

1. Take Fremont Exit (on right side of bridge).
2. Proceed 1 block and turn right on Mission.
3. Continue 4 blocks to the Embarcadero and turn left.

4. Proceed about 1.5 miles to Pier 27, turn right into Pier 27.

#### From South of San Francisco

1. Take 280 North.
2. Exit at end of 280 Freeway at King.
3. Continue 3 blocks on King which turns into the Embarcadero traveling north.
4. Proceed about 2 miles to Pier 27, turn right into Pier 27.

#### **Parking Information**

- Parking operated by Imperial Parking (Impark)
- Located at 80 Francisco St. Garage, San Francisco, CA 94133
- Is within walking distance to the cruise terminal

- The cost is USD \$18 per calendar day for cars and \$28 for oversized vehicles.
